How did Great Britain's need for resources cause the Opium War?

Opium Wars

China

Background: Early 1880s, British were importing opium from India to China

Chinese government said “hey! STOP!” (opium is a very addictive drug)

When the British did not stop, China tried to stop the trade... this led to first Opium War, 1840

Britain won... again and the opium trade continued

Essential Question

What were the effects of China's loss in the Opium War?

Effects of the first Opium War

British win, as usual.

First Opium War ends with the Treaty of Nanking. Five ports are opened for trade; the Chinese have to pay the British \$21 million in basically lost profits; and British get island of Hong Kong.

Effects of the second Opium War

British win, as usual. This time with France on their side.

First Opium War ends with the a treaty which legalizes the trade of opium; establishes freedom of religion; awards Britain AND France money damages for lost profits; and opens another port for trade.
